We wanted to address concerns that are being shared and frustrations that have come up regarding grading and work being completed in Canvas but showing incomplete in the grade book. 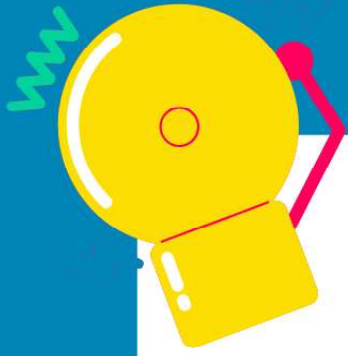
Want to help your student start planning for life after high school, make sure everything is ready for graduation? Good news - Naviance is here to help!
