VPrep Attendance Policy

To ensure our students are meeting the appropriate number of hours annually, the following breakdown is the suggested amount of time each day a student participates in live class sessions and uses Canvas:

Kindergarten (1/2 day)
2 hours 45 minutes
1st -8th = 5 hours 30 minutes
9th/10th = 6 hours

Canvas talks to PowerSchool nightly.

VPrep Attendance Policy

Ms. Boykin adjusts the attendance if a parent notifies her that the student will be missing any portion of their online time throughout the day, i.e. they're sick or have an appt.

The student needs to be logged into Canvas for their full amount of time daily, and if they aren't, they log their time via the offline tracker. Once the teacher approves the time, it reflects the student being present for that day.

Teachers do not take attendance on students who attend live lessons. All attendance is completed using a computer tracking system.

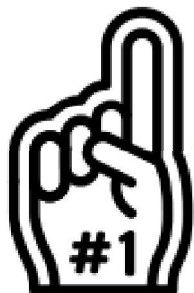

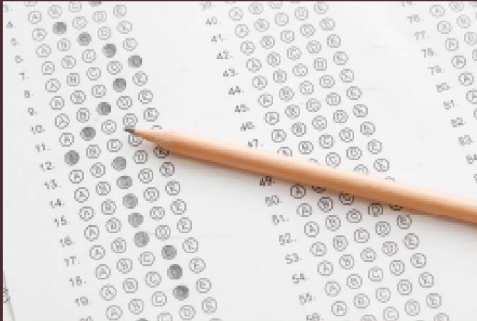
