A Message from the Head of School

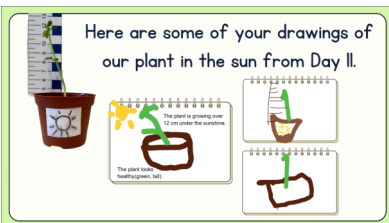
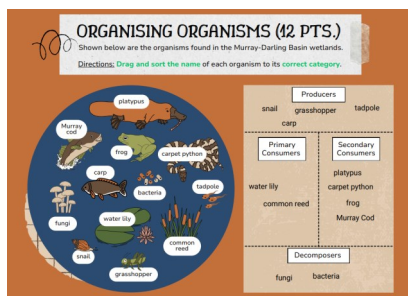
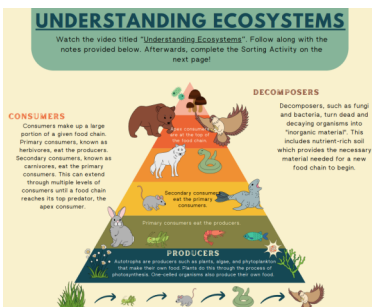
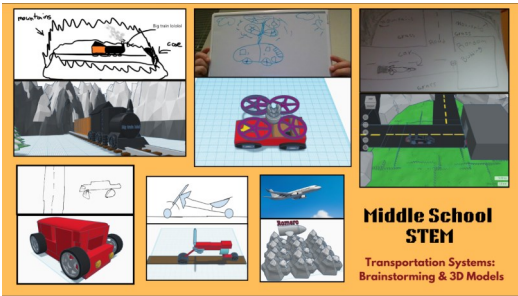
